Sutherland Secondary School Honoured by the City of North Vancouver with an Advisory Design Panel Award

March 4, 2013 - We are pleased to announce Sutherland Secondary School was honoured by the City of North Vancouver's Advisory Design Panel with an Award of Merit.

The Award of Merit was presented at North Vancouver City Hall on Monday, March 4th, 2013 by North Vancouver Mayor Darrell Mussatto, to representatives from the North Vancouver School District, Cristina Marghetti, Greg Erickson and George Boorman of KMBR Architects Planners, and landscape Architect Rod Maruyama of Maruyama & Associates Inc. The award is in recognition of contributions to the promotion of design excellence in building and landscape architecture.

Completed in 2008 Sutherland Secondary is a school for 1000 students, grades 8 to 12, built to replace an existing school. The School District envisioned a contextually sensitive school that was architecturally pleasing - "not just a box" - with an animated façade to the street. The vision included incorporating sustainable design principles, maximizing natural light as well as transparency through the building from the front of the school to the fields at the back.
